After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Lyssy and seconded by Councilmember Rosales to approve the Consent Agenda. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.

- (3) Park Improvements- Discussion/Take any necessary action concerning ongoing park projects – CM Evans informed the Council that he spoke to Liska Construction, he will start on the pond within the next 2 weeks. He also informed the Council of the status of the splash pad project. No action taken.
- (4) Discussion/Take any necessary action concerning the repairs to the Karnes City Library building – CM Evans informed the Council that repairs have been done, they are in the process of cleaning and putting books back on the shelves. No action taken.

G. NEW BUSINESS (CONSIDER AND ACT UPON):

- (5) Discussion/Take any necessary action concerning the Annual 2017/2018 Financial Audit submitted by Armstrong, Vaughan & Associates, P.C. Phil Vaughan with Armstrong, Vaughan & Associates presented the Council with the 2017/2018 Annual Financial Audit. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Ebrom and seconded by Councilmember Rosales to approve the 2017/2018 Financial Audit as presented. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.
- (6) Discussion/Take any necessary action concerning the annual contract with Little League Eric Martinez with Karnes City Little league reviewed the contract with the Council. Mr. Martinez and the Council discussed changing the effective date to start on January 22, 2019 and ending on August 31, 2019 and also allowing little league to prep the baseball/softball fields before and after all games. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.

The Council discussed the procedures and timeline of the project. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Lyssy and seconded by Councilmember Ebrom to approve the steps and procedures within the report and being the process of advertising and receiving competitive bids for the project. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.
