Discuss and consider extending the Declaration of Health Disaster Area** – Mayor Skloss informed the Council that the existing declaration signed on March 20, 2020 was only for 7 days, we can extend the declaration for another 30 days and if needed revoke it sooner. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Loya and seconded by Councilmember Rosales to approve the extension of the Declaration of Health Disaster Area. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.

Update on measures by the City of Karnes City to address the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic** – Mayor Skloss updated the Council and Citizens of the ongoing weekly meetings the Mayor and City Department heads have been having, we are monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic closely and will make any necessary changes as needed. Karnes County Judge Wade Hedtke informed the Council that the County is doing the same and would stay in touch with the City. No action taken.
