
Others present were: City Manager/Secretary Veronica Butler, and Director of Public works Fernando Rios and Haylee Jurgajtis

NEW BUSINESS – “CONSIDER AND ACT UPON”:


- 5. Discuss, consider and take possible action on the recommendation from WTC Engineering on the request from James Rosales for improvements on lowering a portion of the alleyway between S. Browne and S. Market Street** – David Young with WTC Engineering presented his recommendation on installing a concrete footing along with a trench drain, he also recommended rebuilding the alley and cleaning out storm drains in the amount of \$12,000. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Loya and seconded by Councilmember Dziuk to approve the recommendation and have it added to our 2025 street improvement project. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed. Councilmember Rosales abstained from voting.
- 6. Discuss and take possible action regarding the 2025 Street Improvement Project** – David Young presented the recommendations. Haylee went over budget amount, CM Butler presented another street to be added, Councilmember Loya mentioned intersections that would need to be looked at. After further discussion Mayor Skloss recommended for the city staff to get a plan in place and bring it back to the council at the regular meeting for approval. No action was taken.
- 7. Adjournment** - There being no further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Rosales and seconded by Councilmember Lyssy to adjourn the

meeting. The vote was 5-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.
