
**NEW BUSINESS – “CONSIDER AND ACT UPON”:**

- 4. Discuss and take possible action on the estimate from C&C Construction in the amount of \$6,100 to replace the sidewalk in front of the Hermann Sons Lodge located at 120 S. Market Street, Karnes City, Texas** – CM Butler presented the Council with the estimate to replace the sidewalks. After further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Dziuk and seconded by Councilmember Hernandez approved the estimate from C&C Construction in the amount of \$6,100 to replace the sidewalk in front of the Hermann Sons Lodge located at 120 S. Market Street, Karnes City, Texas. The vote was 4-0 in favor and the motion was declared unanimously passed.

**(A) Discussion regarding prospective business development**


